

# *Cubans in Mexico Fight Over Body in Cemetery*

MEXICO, D. F., Sept. 6.—After a fight between Communists and members of the Cuban ABC revolutionary organization today in Dolores Cemetery the body of Julio Antonio Mella, Cuban student leader, was exhumed and cremated in preparation for shipment to Cuba, but the ashes were stolen mysteriously from the funeral director.

The ceremony was first interrupted by Communists, who attempted to seize the coffin with shouts of "Don't take him; he's ours."

Police reserves intervened to protect the ABC members, who finally exhumed the body. Several men and five women described as Communists were held, and several members of the ABC were arrested but later released.

Mella was assassinated here in 1929.
