Cuban Army Suspends Night Flying Privileges for Private Aircraft

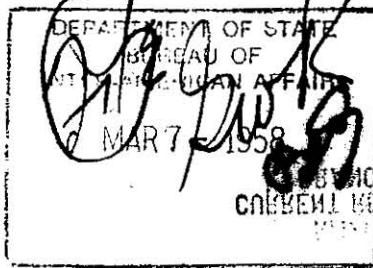

The Embassy has now received Note No. C-336 dated February 18, 1958, from the Ministry of State, confirming the fact that the Cuban military authorities have ordered the suspension of flights by private sport planes over national territory between the hours of 5:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m. A copy of the Ministry's note together with a free translation are enclosed.

Law-Decree No. 633 of January 15, 1953, referred to in the note embodies the "Administrative Technical Agreement to Facilitate Flight Notifications of Private Flights Between Cuba and the United States" (Embassy D-1167, January 29, 1953).
