Amembassy Habana reports that in TV interview March 11 Faure Chomont leader of Directorio Revolucionario, stated DR would not accept Communism but advocated establishment relations with Russia and satellite countries including Red China.

Directorio Revolucionario is an anti-Batista revolutionary group originally associated with Havana University Students' Union. It is separate from Castro's July 26 movement and does not participate in Castro Government. While objective both groups was overthrow Batista, interests have not always coincided.
