Jose Manuel Aleman, former Cuban Minister of Education, who has been residing in Miami recently, informed military intelligence sources in that city on October 12 that he had reliable information from his paid Dominican informant that President Trujillo had spent large sums of money to cause a political uproar in Cuba. Aleman also stated that according to the same informant Trujillo and his brothers have been seriously considering the possibility of invading Cuba. Aleman stated he spends \$50,000 monthly in Cuba and the Dominican Republic to be kept informed.
