VENEZUELA READY TO ACCUSE CASTRO

CARACAS, Venezuela, Nov. 8 (UPI)—Venezuela was reported ready today to accuse Cuba's Castro regime of smuggling war materiel into the country to arm the terrorist underground.

An informed source said the Government was "almost 90 per cent sure" that three tons of arms and munitions hidden on a lonely beach came from Cuba.

Although serial numbers had been obliterated from the weapons seized, it was said that laboratory analysis showed they were not from Venezuelan military stocks.

The question of the arms cache was considered almost certain to be raised by Venezuela at the December meeting of the Organization of American States.
