MEXICAN WAR (Federal Service)

Muster Roll of Captain Henry Forno's Company of Artillery,
Battalion of La. Vol. Militia commanded by
Major Louis Gally ordered into service of
the United States, by Major General E. P. Gaines, U.S.A.,
from the 19th August to 19th November 1845

Muster Roll of Captain Eusebe S. Bersier's Company of Artillery of the
Louisiana Legion of Militia, ordered into Service of the
United States by Major General Edmund P. Gaines, U.S.A.,
This Company enrolled on 21 August 1845, at New Orleans,
by Major S. Cooper for a period of three (3) months.

Muster Roll of Captain Isaac F. Stockton's (A company of the Washington
Regiment First Brigade of La. Militia commanded by Brig.
General P. F. Smith ordered into Service of the United
States by Isaac Johnson, Governor of Louisiana from
5 May 1846 to 4 August 1846.
This company enrolled 5 May 1846 by Captain Van Horn for a
period of six (6) months.
