Col. Titus and his Kansas company did not arrive at New-Orleans in time to proceed to Nicaragua in the steamship Texas.

The Norfolk papers report the rumored loss of the ship Prince de Joinville, of that port, with all on board.

New Orleans papers of Tuesday contain advices from Northern Mexico to the 17th ult.
