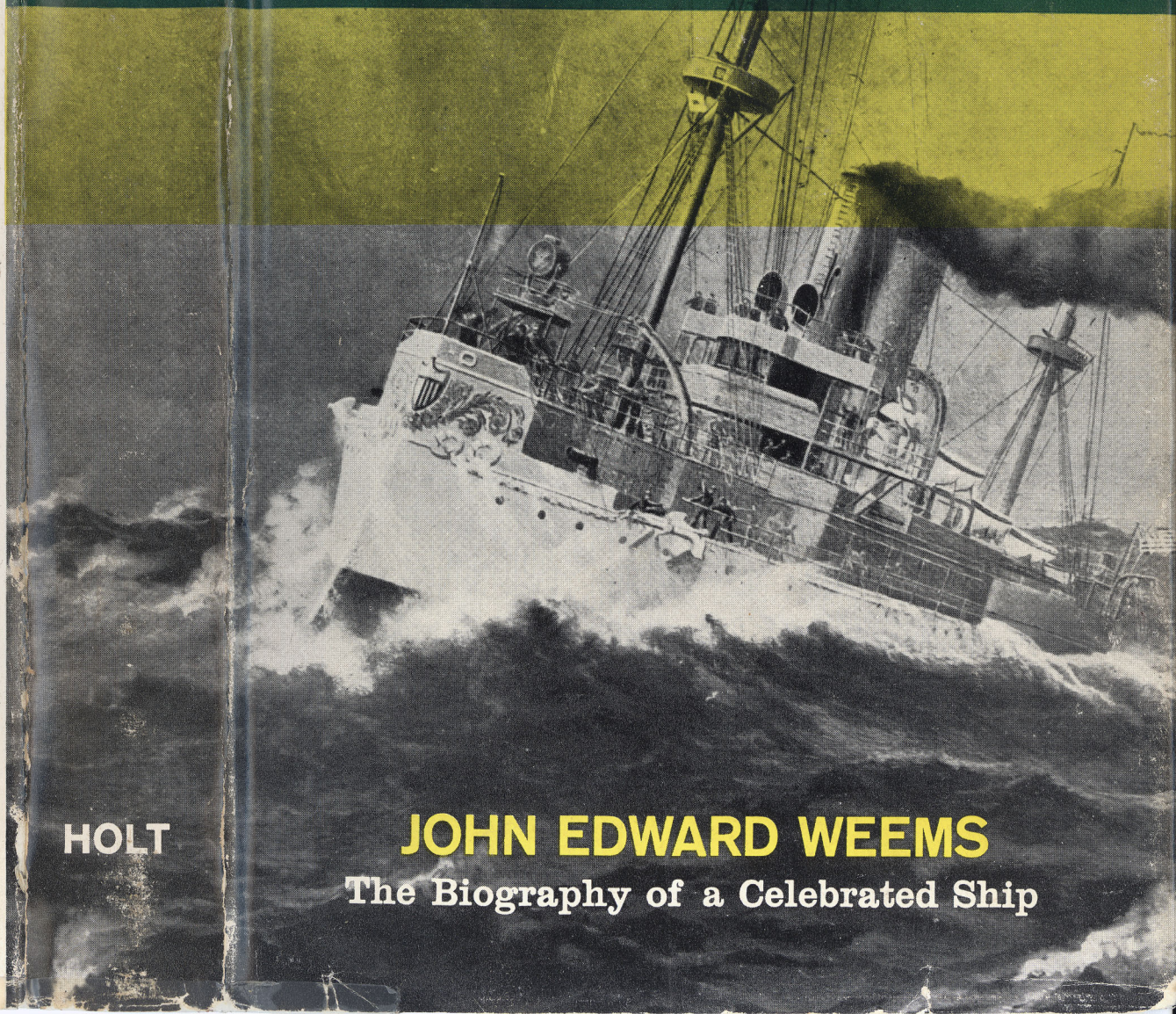

Two officers, Jenkins (of Allegheny City, Pa.) and Merritt (of Red Oaks, Ia.), died in the explosion. Another, Blandin (of Baltimore, Md.), died several months later. Four officers—Bowers, Washington, McCarthy, and Hill—were not aboard when the ship blew up.

The following list of the crew, all of whom were aboard, shows 250 as missing or dead and eight as having died within the next few days. With the two deaths among the officers, this gives a total of 260. Other accounts, probably taking into consideration subsequent deaths that could be blamed on the explosion, list 266 fatalities.
