

The original and each copy of an application for a passport must have attached to it a copy of the applicant's photograph. A loose signed photograph of the applicant must accompany the application. The photographs must be on thin paper, should have a light background, and be not over three inches in size.

This blank must be completely filled out. The legal fee of one dollar, in currency or postal money order, and the applicant's certificate of naturalization must accompany the application. The rules should be carefully read before mailing the application to the Department of State, Division of Passport Control, Washington, D. C.

that I emigrated to the United States, sailing from Cuba about 1896.; that I resided seven years, uninterruptedly, in the United States,

from 1896 to 1903 at New York City; that I was naturalized as a citizen of the United States before the Supreme Court

Court of State of New York at New York, N.Y. on Jan. 20th, 1902, as shown by the Certificate of Naturalization presented herewith;

that I am the IDENTICAL PERSON described in said Certificate; that I have resided outside the United States since my naturalization at the following places for the following periods:

and that I am domiciled in the United States, my permanent residence being at New York, in the State of New York, where I follow the occupation of my family affairs
