### Preface

This reference aid lists personalities in key positions in the Cuban Communist Party (PCC); national and provincial governments; military organizations; selected mass, public service, cultural, scientific and press organizations; and the diplomatic service as of 15 March 1992. This directory contains a table of contents, an alphabetical index of organization and personality names, and the dates on which individuals assumed their positions. It supercedes LDA 91-12423, dated August 1991. Suggestions, corrections, updating information, and comments are welcome and appreciated.

As a result of the Fourth Party Congress in October 1991, the Central Committee Secretariat was eliminated and its members and functions incorporated into the Politburo. Non-voting membership in both the Politburo and Central Committee was converted to full membership. The new Central Committee has 225 members, 25 of which also serve on the new Politburo.
