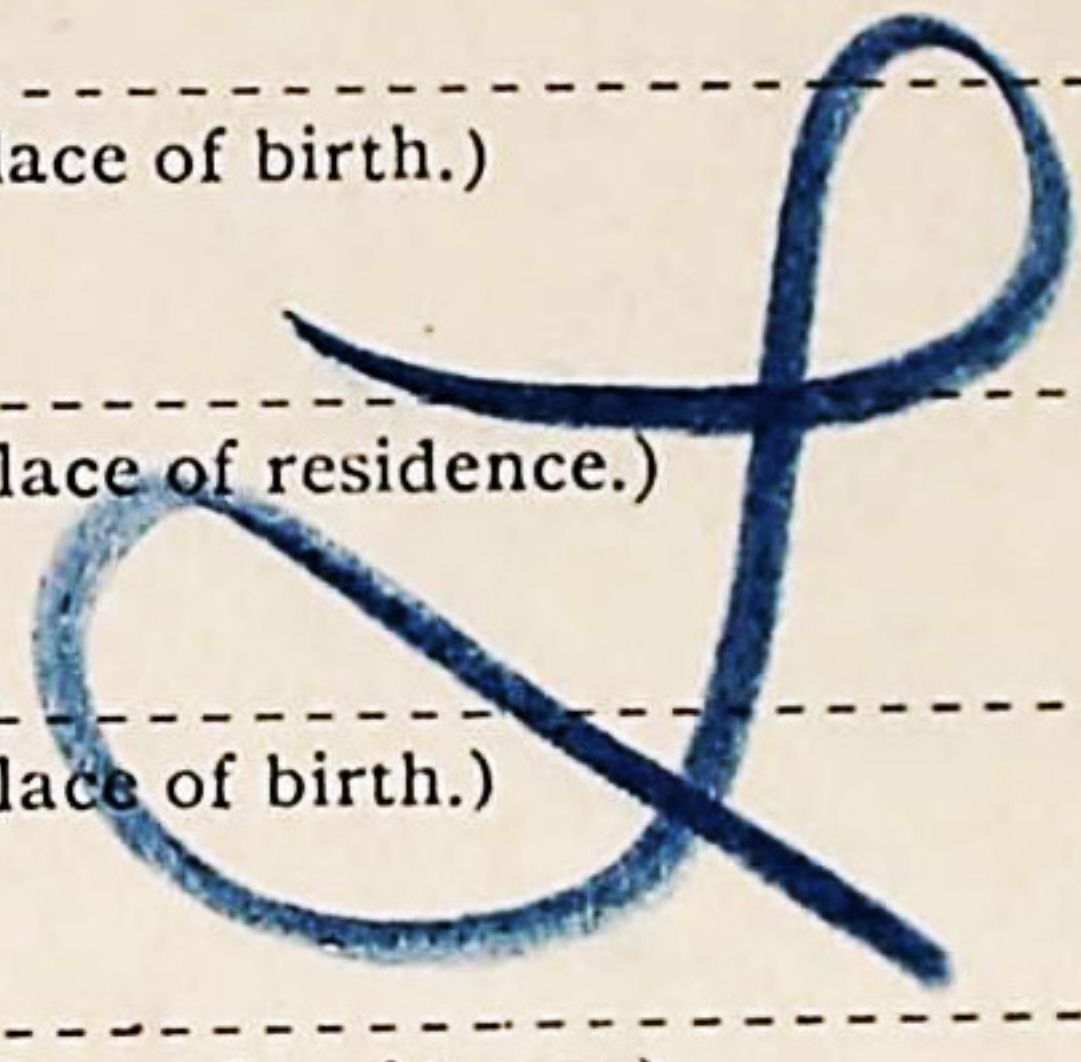


CERTIFICATE OF REGISTRATION OF AMERICAN CITIZEN.
