Licens's for keeping liquor stores shall be numbered one, and shall confer a right on the holders thereof to sell wine, neal and spirituous liquors, in quantilies not less than one quart, but on permission of not permitting or suffering the same to be drank or consumed at the place where they are sold.

Licenses for retailing taverns shall be numbed teo, and shall confer a right on the holders thereof to entertain and accommodate white pracos as abourlers, lodgers, or visitors, with their families or servants.

Licenses for keeping retail shops shall pe numbered three, to be recommended by three persons as above, and shall confer a right on the holders thereof to self wine, malt, and spirituous Liquors, from three gallons to any smaller quantity, with permission to have the same drank and consumed at the place where such liquor is retailed: Provided, that no liquor shall be sold to any negro don to be drank in the shep or place where the same shall be sold.

The application must also be accompanied with the oath required by the act of the Legislature, of December 1834.
