Wights and Measures in the said city and for other furfi ses therein mentioned. WIEREAS it is necessary to testiain the

trading of slaves and other persons of Colour, in regetable and other Market Produce, and Poultre, which, at present, is carried on in the Market, to the great detriment of the Farmers and highly disadvantageous to the citizens:-BEst ordained by the Intendant and II arden

of Charleston, in City Council assembled, and its is hereby ordained by the au harity of the same, That from and efter the passing of this otdinance, it shall not be lawful for any slave or persons of colour, to sell or dispose of in said Markets of

Charleston, or elsewhere any refetable or garden produce of poultry of any description whatever, on his or her account, or for and on account of any other slave or person of colour; and that no slave or person of colour; and that no clave or person of colour shall be specialited to sell or dispose of in the sti Market, or elsewhere in the city, any vegetable or garden produce, or poultry, of any description whatever, other than such as is raised upon, or is the growth or produce of the Garden or Farm of his or her owner, or one-

ployer or the representative of the same, and not without a ticket specifying the name of the slave or person of colour so selling, together with the different articles, and coruffing that the said vegetable or garden produce and poultry, are he growth and were raked upon the karm or Gaden of him or her so certifying. A d every free person of colour herein in anywise offending shall, for each an 'every such offence, forfeit and pay the sum of Twenty Dollars; and every slave shall for each and every such offen e, be pet for one hour in the Stocks at the Certic Market, and he liable to accene at the same, not less than the man to teen at the same, not less than ten nor more plan twenty lastes on the bare back, to be adjudged by any "tw Commissioners of the said Maken, and to be inflicted by the Claiks the configuration of the configur

man kethout s, or egorgatije execution otspuch puntsiment, togge undergelje the Clock of the said Market the sum of five collars, such share shall the cupped by telested from the coulously dunish-ment by kin or her incursed as aforesaid. And every article offered for sale byta slave, without a proper ticket as aforesaid, shall moreover be forproper tetter and person or passing seizing the same.

And be it further ordains of the authority after said. That so much of every Ordinance repulginant cold. That so much of every viciniance repugnant hereto, be and the same is hereby repealed.
