

The Negro Troubles in Kentucky and Tennessee.

LOUISVILLE, Dec. 20th.—The Russellville Herald of Wednesday last, says that the negro insurrection excitement exists in the neighborhood of Volney and Gordonsville. A number of negroes had been arrested. A negro at one of the Iron Works in Tennessee said he knew all about the plot, but would die before he would tell. He thereupon received seven hundred and fifty lashes, from which he died.

At Cadiz, Trigg Co., Ky., yesterday, a free negro was hung, after being tried by a Vigilance Committee.

There are a number more in jail, some of whom will be hung. Judge Cook has called a meeting of the Court for Christmas day. Excitement runs very high.
