A BOLD STAND AGAINST INTEMPER-ANCE.

The members of a Presbyterian Church in this city have recently formed themselves into a Temperance Society, and unanimously resolved that they will not manufacture or sell, or be engaged in the manufacture or sale of spirituous liquors, nor suffer any intoxicating liquor to be drunk in their families, except when prescribed by a physician, or in cases of sickness. They have also resolved unanimously, that they will make it an indispensable prerequisite to admission into their pale, that the candidate or candidates shall agree not to become engaged in the sale or manufacture of spirituous liquors, nor to drink suc's liquors except for the reasons above mentioned.

This is strong ground, it is true: but it is taken against a strong and dangerous foe,—the enemy slike of God and man. N. Y. Obs.
