

A Body Snatcher Convicted.

ATLANTA, GA., Dec. 23.—Geo. Vaughn, the colored janitor of the Atlanta Medical College, charged with stealing the body of Wm. Johnson, a prominent citizen, from the grave, for dissection, was convicted to-day, and will probably be sentenced to six months hard labor. There is great excitement in Marietta, whence the body was stolen, and families are opening their graves to see if their relatives have been disturbed.
