
ANTONIO LUACES, THE EMINENT CUBAN REBEL.

Antonio Luaces, a rebel surgeon, was executed by the Spaniards at Puerto Principe, Cuba, on the 20th inst. The deceased patriot was the representative of one of the most distinguished families at Puerto Principe. He was a gentleman of culture and refinement, a citizen soldier. Ranking very high in the estimation of his countrymen, it was at one time considered that he would be called to fill the place which was made vacant by the death of the illustrious Agramonte; but the position was ultimately conferred, perhaps in consonance with Luaces' personal wish, on Señor Gomez.
