LYNCHERS LYNCHED Megroes Take Summary Action on

Negre Murderer and Are in Turn Lynched. Ocals. Fig., June 12.—Two negroes

were lynched at Dunnellon last evening by an infuriated mob of their own colcr. Some weeks ago Marshal Payne was shot by a negro. Saturday the neero was captured and returned to Dunnellon, when it is supposed some negroes were employed to take him down the river and drown him. Sunday evening the laborers of the Dunnellon Phosphate mine heard of it, and at once organized to meet out similar justice to those implicated. They succeeded in lynching two of the men and were only prevented from lynching nine others by the appearance of Sheriff Nugent and an armed posse, who went down in a special train from Ocala. The posse

returned this morning and reported

everything quiet.
