

LYNCHED.—Dr. Linton, formerly of the U. S. Navy, was recently lynched and hung at Laredo, Texas, by the U. S. soldiers. It appears that Linton had insulted the wife of Centro, an Italian musician, who resented the insult, whereupon Linton first shot Carero, a Mexican musician, who interfered, and then shot Centro. He then escaped to the Mexican side of the Rio Grande, committed some other outrage, and was imprisoned, when the soldiers went over, took him from the authorities, and executed him on the Plaza.
