NEGROES LYNCHED. A party of four negroes accused of murder, in Louisville, were tried and acquitted on Wednesday, although one of them turned State's evidence. Notwithstanding this, on Wednesday night, the populace attacked the jail, took the men out and hong two of them. A third cut his throat and died. The one who turned State's evidence was unmolested. The acquittal of the parties in court is said to have been owing to the fact that the latter's evidence was not legally corroborated.
