THE NEGRO WHO KILLED FARMER CHANSION AT PADJETTO.

For Candler Has Issued a Reward for His Capture—Wife of the Murdered Man Waats to See Him Executed.

ATLANTA, April 13—Governor Candier late this afternoon offered a reward of \$250 for the apprehension and delivery to the sheriff of Fulton county, at the fail in Atlanta, of Sum Hose, a negro, who last night killed Alfred Cranford, a well known young white farmer, who lives four miles from Palmetto, Gar.

Hose killed Cranford yesterday eye-

ning while the farmer was sitting at supper with his write. The negro suddenly walked in at the open door and before. Mrs. Cranford could utter a word of warning struck her husband a terrile blow with an av in the back of the head, fracturing the skull and outsing death in a short time. and all day long the chees has continued throughout Campbell and into Coweta counties. The negro's coat was found and the posse, with their dogs, are hot on the trail, but at a late hour tonight the negro had not been caught. A clitten of Falmetto, who arrived in Atlanta on a late night train, says Mra. Cranford has awked permission to witness the execution of the negro who

killed her husband, but this will not be permitted.

The impression is general in the little town that the negro will be burned di the stake when caught.
