"DRUMMED" OUT OF THE REGIMENT .- Private Alenson Rontly of K Company, 1st Dragoons, convicted of desertion and horse stealing, was sentenced by the court mortial lately in session at Fort Buchange, to receive fifty lashes with a cowhide well laid on the bare back, to be confined at hard labor until January, 1862, heavily iroped, to forfeit all pay due him, to have his head shaved, and be branded with a red hot fron with the letter D, to be drummed

with a red hot from with the letter D, to be draumed out of the service, and receive a dishonorable discharge. Privates Rice, Donavan and Young, were also tried, and sentenced to be whipped and draumed

out of the service; but the commanding officer of the department, in accordance with the recommendation of the court, remitted their punishment and

restored them to duty.
